The Shire of Plantagenet's RoadWise Bi-Annual Driver Reviver was held on Friday 22 September 2018 at the new truck stop at the intersection of Albany Highway and Great Southern Highway. Driver Reviver road stops provide the opportunity for road users to stop and refresh, in the hope of reducing the level of fatigue related trauma on our roads.

'Driving while exhausted is risky' said Elsa Drage, St John Ambulance volunteer. 'Ultimately, whether it is you who is tired or the other guy on the road, all of us are potentially at risk. We need to be conscious of how we feel on a particular day and we need to be alert to the actions of others. Driver Reviver stops are one way for you to stop and relax, grab a coffee, drink of water, take advantage of the facilities and have a chat with friendly people - take time out to re-charge'
