

New Shire President for Plantagenet

At a Special Meeting of the Council held on 24 October 2017 the Councillors of the Shire of Plantagenet elected a new Shire President and Deputy Shire President.

Councillor Chris Pavlovich, who was first elected to the Council in 2011, opposed the incumbent Shire President Ken Clements. Cr Clements has been Shire President since 2009.

In a close vote Cr Pavlovich was declared Shire President.

Cr Pavlovich said upon his election that he is looking forward to working with all Councillors and senior staff to achieve the long term strategic directions of the Council.

The election for Deputy Shire President then occurred with Cr Jon Oldfield being declared elected unopposed.

The balance of the meeting dealt with the formation and membership of committees and external representation.
