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Not a Waste of Time

At the Council Meeting held on 23 May 2017, it was resolved to appoint Cleanaway as the waste contractor for the Shire of Plantagenet's kerbside waste and recycle collection. The contract is to run for the next three years with an option for renewal of up to six years.

Shire President Cr Ken Clements acknowledged the public discussion around the waste contract since Warren Blackwood Waste sold their business in late 2016, however, expressed excitement over having a formal contract in place once again. 'I would like to thank Cleanaway for continuing to offer a waste service to the residents of the Shire of Plantagenet during the last six months and I would also like to thank the community for their patience during this time,' he said.

Cleanaway is the largest waste management company in Australia with major investments in infrastructure in the region. 'They are leaders in the field of waste management and the new contract will offer a seamless transition in the service with no effect on residents,' said Dominic Le Cerf, Manager of Works & Services.

Residents need to ensure that all household rubbish is placed in the 120L blue bin, whilst all commingled recycling is placed loosely (and not in plastic bags) in the 240L green recycling bin. More information will be made available in the next month to remind residents which items can be replaced in their recycling bin.
