

INFRASTUCTURE BOND

The Shire of Plantagenet has previously experienced damage to its roads, footpaths, verges and kerbs during periods of building and construction. To enable the Shire to protect its assets, a refundable bond is required to repair any infrastructure damage to its original condition if required.

Conditions

Damage to infrastructure

- Damage to property owned by the Shire of Plantagenet (eg lids, grates, drainage structure, kerbs, footpaths and roads) must be reported to the Shire immediately to consider options for repairs.
- All materials, such as sand, soil, cement, rubbish and natural materials must not be allowed to enter into the Shire's drainage system. Materials must be stored in a manner that prevents them being effected by wind drift.

Building materials may be stored on the verge subject to the following conditions:

- Storage must be placed so that it does not cause obstruction to sightlines in any way for vehicles and pedestrians and does not prohibit access for pedestrians
- There is to be no damage caused to any Shire property in the road and verge area such as a sign, kerb, footpath, street tree or garden maintained by the Shire.
- Materials must be stored in such a way that no obstruction or damage is caused to a manhole, inspection pit, fire hydrant, water or gas valve, electrical substation, power pole, drainage gully or any other service in the verge area to which access may be required.
- Materials must not be placed on a service in the verge area that is not covered with a trafficable lid.
- Materials must not be stored on any other verge or property.
- No building activity is to be carried out in the verge area; this includes cutting, mixing, preparing and assembling all work is to be carried out within the building site.
- If there is a street tree or trees, a clear area around the tree is to be maintained in order to prevent damage to the tree/s.
- On project completion, the site and verge must be cleared of all materials including sand and returned to the state prior to the commencement of the project.
