- Wandering livestock
- Littering and illegal dumping
- Abandoned vehicles
- Parking and vehicle matters
- Illegal camping
- General local law enquiries

Rangers can help you understand your responsibilities and respond to issues affecting public safety, amenity and the community.



Emergency Services and Bushfire

The Shire supports local emergency management and bushfire preparedness.

We can assist with information about:

- Firebreak requirements
- Burning periods
- Permits to burn
- Bushfire preparedness
- Harvest and Vehicle Movement Bans
- Local emergency arrangements
- Volunteer bush fire brigades

If you are new to a rural or bushfire-prone property, please contact us early to understand your responsibilities before the fire season.

When to Contact Us

- Need information about local laws
- Want to better prepare your property for bushfire season
