Waste Collection Services

The Shire of Plantagenet contracts Cleanaway to operate the 120L household rubbish bin and 240L recycling bin collection for the townsites of Mount Barker, Kendenup, Narrikup and Rocky Gully.

Rubbish collection day in the Shire of Plantagenet is every Thursday, with the exception of Rocky Gully which is collected every Monday.

(Cleanaway can be contacted on 6801 7500 for waste or recycling enquiries)

Household Blue 120L waste bins are collected weekly.

Commercial 240L rubbish bins are collected weekly.

Recycling Green 240L bins are collected fortnightly and broken up into the following zones:

Mount Barker EAST of Albany Highway and the Rocky Gully townsite.

Mount Barker WEST of Albany Highway, Kendenup townsite, and Narrikup townsite.

Rinse off food from items and place recyclables loosely in the bin. DO NOT bag items in soft plastic bags as these are <u>not</u> recyclable and will contaminate the load.

Rubbish Bins

It is the owner/occupiers' responsibility to purchase and maintain a wheelie rubbish bin. Owner/occupiers are responsible for the general cleanliness and maintenance of the bin and are also responsible for the replacement of lost or stolen bins.

DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN HOUSEHOLD WASTE OR RECYCLING BINS

- Hot ashes;
- Building rubble;
- Hazardous chemicals and substances;
- Aerosol cans
- Tyres;
- Car parts; and
- Green waste.

Follow these guidelines to ensure your bin is emptied:

- Make sure your bin is not too full or over flowing;
- Place items loosely in the bin so that they fall out when emptied avoid jamming items into your bin;

- Place bins up to 1.5 metres from the edge of the road and if more than one bin, place them one metre apart;
- Avoid placing bins near obstacles such as trees, power lines, awnings, eaves and vehicles;
- Ensure the wheels of the bin face the house with the lid opening towards the road;
- · Contain all items within the bin, as no excess waste will be collected; and
- Put bins out **before 5.00am** on the day of collection.

Reasons your bin may not have been emptied, include:

- The bin was too heavy or too full;
- It may have contained inappropriate materials such as building or hazardous waste;
- It was not placed out in time for collection;
- The bin was not placed correctly e.g. facing the wrong way, too far away from the edge of the road or too close to another bin;
- The bin was located near an obstruction such as trees or telephone poles; and
- Access to the bin was blocked by a vehicle.
- The bin might be in very poor condition requiring maintenance or replacement.

Waste Disposal Sites

O'Neill Road Waste Management Facility - O'Neill Road, Mount Barker just south of the Mount Barker Golf Club off Albany Highway.

Kamballup Landfill Site - near the hall on Woogenellup Road, 600 metres from Chester Pass Road.

Kendenup Transfer Station - approximately 3kms from Kendenup along Lake Matilda Rd.

Porongurup Transfer Station - Surrey Downs Rd approximately 1.3 kms from Porongurup Rd.

Rocky Gully Transfer Station Arbour Rd Rocky Gully approximately just past the old Primary School.

Tip Passes

Ratepayers who do not receive a weekly household waste collection may be entitled to a tip pass which enables them to deposit a limited amount of household waste at the Shire's waste sites. The tip pass is posted to the property owner prior to the beginning of each financial year. Tip pass rules are explained below.

When rubbish is deposited at a waste disposal site, the tip pass will be 'punched' depending on the amount of rubbish being disposed. Each tip pass token will enable the user to deposit the equivalent of one 240L mobile garbage bin (MGB) OR Car boot, Station Wagon, Van OR Ute load; OR Trailer load (less than $1.8 \times 1.2 \text{m}$). Tokens are valid for the dates outlined on the tip pass.

If customers need to depose of more waste than allotted on the tip pass, they will need to purchase a prepaid refuse disposal voucher from the Shire of Plantagenet Administration Offices, before going to the waste disposal site.

Where new owners move into a property, the tip pass should remain with the property. If the new owners do not receive the pass or in the event of a pass being lost, then a new pass will not be issued.

In such cases, the ratepayer will be obliged to purchase a prepaid refuse disposal voucher from the Shire of Plantagenet Offices.

Tip passes (or unused portions thereof) are not refundable or redeemable for cash.

Prepaid Refuse Disposal Vouchers

As our tip sites are cash free, it is necessary to purchase Prepaid refuse disposal vouchers from the Shire Office, Lowood Road, Mount Barker or over the telephone by credit card.

Prepaid refuse disposal vouchers are required by the following who intend to deposit chargeable waste at Shire waste disposal sites:

- Ratepayers and residents who receive a weekly refuse collection service and have excess waste;
- Rural ratepayers and residents who intend to deposit chargeable waste or more waste than allotted on the tip passes;
- Rural ratepayers and residents who have lost their tip pass;
- Rural ratepayers and residents who have moved into the district and who have not received a tip pass from the previous owner/occupier;
- Other user (Commercial Customers refer below).

Shire of Plantagenet based business owners who deposit waste regularly may apply for an account from the Shire Office, Lowood Road, Mount Barker. A record of waste disposed of is completed on disposal and signed by the account holder and a monthly account will be issued. Please note that tip site keys will no longer be issued to business customers.

All waste disposal is to take place during normal tip site operating hours.

Waste Disposal Fees

A fee applies for the disposal of waste items that are not recyclable at the waste disposal sites.

No charge is made on the following items:

- Separated co-mingled recyclables (plastic bottles, cans, household cardboard, paper, glass);
- Batteries (car, truck etc);
- Uncontaminated timber;
- Uncontaminated green waste;
- Clean fill;

All other waste, including household waste, is chargeable.

Prepaid refuse disposal vouchers can be purchased in the following units:

04 Tokens \$32.00
10 Tokens \$80.00
20 Tokens \$160.00
52 Tokens \$416.00

Token values are based on the current price of rubbish collection per 240 litre MGB.
