4 REPORTS OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS AND OFFICERS

4.1 REVIEW SHIRE OF PLANTAGENET RAV NETWORK

The Committee continued to categorise the remaining Shire roads using the proposed system from the meeting held 20 March 2012.

The Committee discussed existing (Main Roads WA) and proposed conditions for all roads. The Committee agreed that where a recommendation has been made to categorise a road as 'uncontrolled', all existing Main Roads WA conditions be removed. Further, where a road has been categorised as 'controlled' a letter of approval from the Shire is required, with a standard set of conditions (to be agreed on by the Heavy Haulage Committee) and additional conditions as recommended.

All roads (excepting the last 11 roads) were reviewed and recommendations provided on the spreadsheet attached.
