5 REPORTS OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS AND OFFICERS

5.1 FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

Discussion was held regarding the frequency of Heavy Haulage Committee meetings. Committee members agreed that consideration should be given to holding meetings as required around budget time and in line with Commodity Route funding application deadlines.

5.2 REVIEW RAV NETWORK FOR SHIRE OF PLANTAGENET ROADS

Mr Le Cerf led a discussion regarding the need to review the Council's Restricted Access Vehicle (RAV) network. Mr Le Cerf noted that currently the Council is able to manage timber trucks hauling on Shire roads, however there is no provision to manage haulage of other commodities such as grain and lime.

Maps from the Main Roads WA – RAV mapping system website were provided to Committee members for discussion. A copy of these maps is attached at Appendix One.

The purpose of the Committee is to assist in the development of a road network which allows for the haulage of commodities, taking into consideration the condition of the roads and the cost of maintaining them. A strategic approach is required to minimise costs and ensure safety is maintained.

The Committee agreed that before a detailed review of the RAV network is undertaken, further information regarding the network, including conditions applied by Main Roads WA needs to be provided. A proposed field for recommendations for changes to the current network should also be provided.

Mr Le Cerf explained that ultimately the purpose of this review will be to bring the RAV network in line with the Council's Road Hierarchy and the Council's Asset Management Plan.

Action: Mr Le Cerf to develop a table including all applicable roads on the RAV network, conditions applied by Main Roads WA and a proposed field for recommendations for changes, to be discussed at the next meeting of the Committee to be held on 20 March 2012.

6 GENERAL BUSINESS / MATTERS ARISING

6.1 DRAFT ASSET MANAGEMENT PLAN

Mr Stewart explained that the Council's draft Asset Management Plan identifies an annual renewal gap for Shire of Plantagenet roads of approximately \$1.7 million. This needs to be taken into consideration when planning for future road use.
