Seeking support for The Stars Descend

This is a joint letter from Annette Carmichael Projects, Friends of the Porongurup and broader community to seek additional financial and in-kind support to carry-out a successful local "The Stars Descend" performance to be on par in quality with the other towns in this project.

The Stars Descend, by Annette Carmichael Projects, is a vast trail of dance performances about climate action and hope. It will be presented in 5 spectacular outdoor settings to celebrate the rich biodiversity and ongoing restoration of a 1000km wildlife pathway, supported by the environmental program called Gondwana Link (a corridor of natural habitat that stretches from Margaret River through to Kalgoorlie). The performance unfolds over five regional locations, 17 March – 1 April in 2023 and will be promoted through a campaign in partnership with Australia's South West and Australia's Golden Outback. Additionally we have engaged publicist, Tracy Routledge to generate a number of national stories about the project.

The project is inspired and informed by consultation with First Nations Elders, scientists and ecological groups. It is co-created by some of Western Australia's most impactful artists, together with local community. Led by award winning creative producer Annette Carmichael, in partnership with ecological organisation Gondwana Link and a host of regional arts organisations, First Nations Elders, environmental and community groups.

In Porongurup, Chapter 3, the project employs a team of artists and a local producer to engage local community members in workshops and contemporary dance learning, through a new artistic process called Distributed 15. Which is a new multi-artform process that explores ways of distributing knowledge, action and shared responsibility for people and the natural world.

Annette Carmichael Projects (ACP) is an arts company that specialises in the creation of contemporary performance made with community members and professional artists. Based in Denmark (Kwoorabup) ACP engages regional artists and arts workers to deliver projects that unite people to improve community wellbeing and bring about social change.

We recently started the local community engagement for this event with a series of meetings and taster workshops and a week of intensive rehearsals. Porongurup came out in force for the project! The smallest town in The Stars Descend, brought the biggest numbers including 28 participants, ranging from 27 to 73 years of age with varied abilities/aliments and experience.





We'd like to acknowledge and thank the Shire for promoting this event but as you know it takes a lot to make an event of this scale a success and we invite the Shire to provide additional support to these community members and make the final performance at Twin Creeks Conservation Reserve the best event possible.
