With the cost-of-living soaring, it is a timely event for those who may be struggling with the expenses of caring for a pet. We can help ease the burden and improve outcomes for pets and pet owners by engaging with them and encouraging them to sustain their connection with RSPCA and the Shire of Plantagenet and their many services.

The funding requested will allow for a greater amount of pet food, and parasite treatment to be handed out at the event, as well as helping to fund the marketing of the event.
