6 MOUNT BARKER MEMORIAL SWIMMING POOL - FUTURE PLANNING

Following the committees visits to regional pools, a Plant Room Condition Assessment Report and Engineers Report were completed to ascertain the condition of the Mount Barker Memorial Swimming Pool facility.

The reports indicated that the pool bowl was sound, however the plant room and equipment was in need of replacement. The change rooms and office also would require major work, or replacement soon.

The Swimming Pool Manager informed the committee of the works planned for this off season including the essential works requiring action prior to the beginning of the season. Direction was sought from the committee about the Council's expectations for future planning for the facility now we are confident that the pool bowl is in sound condition.

The committee acknowledged that the facility will need upgrading in the future and that the Council should proceed with planning for future development. This will enable projects to be 'shovel ready' should funding become available.
