## 5 MOUNT BARKER REC.CENTRE MEMBERSHIP AND ACCESS

Integration of the membership and access systems for the Rec.Centre was discussed. It was noted that the current security access system was old and is in need of timely replacement and this will be at an estimated cost of \$10,000.00.

An alternative would be to extend the swipe tag system used at Sounness Park to add an additional administrator, the Rec.Centre. This may be a cost effective solution if the system can interface with the Plexus point of sale system.

The Manager Community Services undertook to continue investigations with the security company and provide the Recreation Advisory Committee with a report, including costs as soon as available.

## 6 MOUNT BARKER MEMORIAL SWIMMING POOL - FUTURE PLANNING

Planning for the future of the Mount Barker Memorial Swimming Pool and the process for decision making was discussed.

Funding for repainting of the pool bowl had been approved and the work will be able to be carried out in the 2017/2018 financial year once the required funds were accumulated as the cost will be in the region of \$80,000.00.

It had been agreed in the past that a facility condition report would be undertaken every five years as the pool was now aged and may require remedial repairs to remain in service.

The committee felt that a 50 metre pool was a point of difference for the Shire of Plantagenet and that a 50 metre pool should remain a service priority.

An option of covering the pool and operating the facility all year around was discussed and the Manager Community Services suggested a trip to visit a range of pools that were either open air, seasonally operated or enclosed.

The pools suggested were; Gnowangerup; Katanning; Manjimup; and, Kondinin.

The Manager Community Services undertook to circulate the published costs of operation for each of those pools and arrange a trip for the Pool Manager, Manager Community Services and Recreation Advisory Committee members to visit a range of pools in the region.
