5 MOUNT BARKER MEMORIAL SWIMMING POOL - FUTURE PLANNING

Following a tour of other similar pools that have been recently upgraded by Crs Bell, Lang and Moir, the committee discussed two potential options for the facility's refurbishment, being;

- Southern Entrance with angled parking along Mead Street. Single building with all facilities included in that building and potential realignment of Mead Street; and,
- 2. Northern Entrance with an extended car park in Apex Park.

Costings for each option will be investigated and provided to the committee prior to concept plans being presented to the Council.

The committee noted the intention of the CEO to get two basic concept plans drawn up for further discussion and for costing of the two options.

7 FROST PARK
