**3 RECREATION PRECINCT PLANNING STUDY**

Draft plans for the Kendenup and Frost / Sounness Park precincts including a development timeline were presented and discussed in detail.

Gerard was asked to consider the following when working on the draft precinct plans:

- (Frost / Sounness Park precinct) Maintain the dam presently shown on the 'Demon Downs' block and extend to increase water storage. Move the junior sporting oval presently shown over the dam site to the west;
- (Frost / Sounness Park precinct) Incorporate parking around the proposed soccer and hockey pitches;
- (Frost / Sounness Park precinct) Identify the land between McDonald Avenue and the proposed training track around the tree plantation for parking;
- (Frost / Sounness Park precinct) Realign the direction of the proposed jockey changerooms / administration office to east - west rather than north – south; and
- (Frost / Sounness Park precinct) Realign the archery shooting zone to north – south rather than east – west. The shooting start point to remain in place and the shooting zone to extend adjacent to the training track boundary.

**Actions:**

**Peter Duncan to review the vesting / ownership of the 'old polocrosse' block (cnr McDonald and Marmion Streets) and adjacent land in relation to the proposed cross country course.**

**Nicole Selesnew to progress discussions with the Public Transport Authority regarding the land adjacent to the railway line in Kendenup.**

**Nicole Selesnew to initiate discussions with ITC and the North Mount Barker Football Club supporters club regarding the future of the timber plantation and Demon Downs respectively.**

**Cr Bill Hollingworth to contact Jim Kirkwood regarding the UWA Community Recreation Centre study outcomes. Forward any outcomes to Gerard Healy.**

Correspondence received from the Kendenup Community Recreation Centre Committee (KCRC) requesting the location of the proposed Community Recreation Centre be altered, was discussed in detail (copy of letter attached).

Two proposals from Gerard Healy were also tabled in response to the KCRC's letter (also attached).

It was agreed that the location of the proposed Community Recreation Centre not be changed as it would invalidate the community consultation and consensus process undertaken thus far.

**Action:**

**Nicole Selesnew to forward a letter to the Kendenup Community Recreation Centre Committee advising that the draft precinct plans would not be altered and the Committee would have an opportunity during the public consultation period to comment.**
