# 4.2 SAFE ROAD USE

4.2.1 ALBANY HIGHWAY PROJECT - PROMOTING DRIVING WITH YOUR HEADLIGHTS ON

Action: Mr Le Cerf to liaise with MRWA, other Councils and landowners as required regarding preferred sites for each of the signs.

Letters have been sent to MRWA seeking approval for the erection of the signs on the Albany Highway Road Reserve. Letters also sent to the Shires of Cranbrook and Kojonup.

Signs have been completed by Albany Signs and are awaiting installation.

Approval is pending from Main Roads WA on the locations for installation.
