5 REPORTS OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS AND OFFICERS

5.1 MANAGER'S REPORT - MAY 2009

Sale Data

(1/5/2009 - 31/5/2009)

Total May numbers including MSA were 5,475 head

75 cattle have received replacement NLIS tags over this time.

Two animals have been put down or removed.

45 bales of hay have been fed out over this time.

169 cattle went through Private/Shipper Weigh.

General Business

(15/5/09 - 18/6/09)

The hay paddock and the area around dams was burnt on 29 May which tidied the area up well.

The chlorination shed has arrived from Perth, We are currently waiting on the concrete pad to be laid which will depend on the weather.

We were not able to complete the cleaning out of the dams due to the amount of rain we have had and will now need to wait until spring to restart.

Howard Hickman started work as a casual on 21 May to mainly assist with the washdown.

Claire Appleby resigned and will finished work on 19 June. She will be going to work for Mitchells transport. Due to Claire leaving, a fair bit of time has been spent on having other members of staff brought up to date with the sale processing.

General maintenance continues with the continuation of re-gravelling the pens and replacing of chains on the lift gates. We should be able to start putting up the boundary fence shortly.

The RSPCA called in on 17 June to inspect some cattle that had arrived in a very poor state. The local vet was called in to assess and do blood and manure samples. Twenty-five animals were seized and further investigations will continue. These animals arrived on Tuesday for the Thursday sale and required both NLIS tagging and ear marking which the vendor had organised a permit for.
