5.1 MANAGER'S REPORT - JULY 2009

Sale Data

(1/7/09 – 31/7/09)

Total July numbers including MSA were 2214 head.

29 cattle have received replacement NILS tags over this time.

One animal have been put down or removed.

58 bales of hay have been fed out.

169 cattle gone through for Private/Shipper Weigh.

General Business

(22/7/09 – 18/8/09)

The chlorination unit has been switched off, in line with discussions at the last Committee meeting.

Dirt pen gravelling on east side will happening when we can organise the gravel up from the pit. We have had a large amount of gravel pushed up.

The boundary fence is now complete. We are now carrying out fencing of the crop area.

Isolation taps for the trough water are complete and located at the base of the main walk way.

Canteen walls have been repainted. The power point causing the power outages has been up graded and the leaking roof in the canteen has been resolved.

We have had problems with the septic system at the main building due to the pump failing to pump liquid to leach drains. This has now been rectified.

Livestock Exchange Consultancy will be here to up date the system on 19/8/2009. The internal dividing wall of the shed has been removed to give better work and storage area.

During discussion, the Saleyards Manager Mr Smith advised of the intention to engage another casual staff member to take on NLIS transfers and other computer work, promote achievement of NSQA accreditation and yard duties.
