5.1 MANAGER'S REPORT – JULY TO AUGUST 2023

SOFT FLOOR MATS - This project has now been completed. Feedback has been very positive.

LIGHT TOWER REPLACEMENT - This project has also now been completed; all looks good and working correctly.

STAFF CANTEEN - Work is continuing to bring the canteen to completion. The Shire Building Maintenance Officer has given his assurance that this will be his priority until the canteen is suitable for use.

ABLUTION BLOCK CONCRETE – Job still to be done, building maintenance will be doing the job and are awaiting fine weather to allow for concrete pour.

DISABLED PARKING BAY – Job still pending, to be done in conjunction with above job, awaiting fine weather and staff.

ALMA AGM & CONFERENCE – This year's conference and AGM were held on the Gold Coast. Erika Henderson attended on behalf of the Saleyards and has provided a report detailing her experience that is provided as an attachment.


AGENTS MEETINGS – Some actions coming out of the recent agents' meetings have been addressed.

- ELDERS Heavy duty gate at access laneway on west side of yards. This has been completed.
- NUTRIEN Change over computer program to Agri-nous. Some research has been done and we have spoken with other saleyards re software programs and submitted a lengthy report to DCEO regarding our findings and recommendations.

ANODES – At the June saleyards advisory committee meeting Cr Bell raised the question on fitting Anodes to the new and existing lighting towers. Wes Sounness from The Tankman is going to give us a quote to purchase and fit sacrificial anodes to the towers.

There was also a discussion in regard to the investigations into the saleyards software replacement. For a number of reasons, the current preferred option is to upgrade the existing software to 'Stockyards,' rather than move to the software preferred by one agent, namely AgriNous. It was noted that further information would be presented to the Committee for formal support of this option.

The purpose of this report is to review the financial position of the Mount Barker Regional Saleyards for the period ending 31 July 2023.

There has been expenditure of \$16,500.00 on capital budget items to date, being the replacement light pole.

Operating income is \$16,444.00, which is \$4,972.00 below YTD budget.
